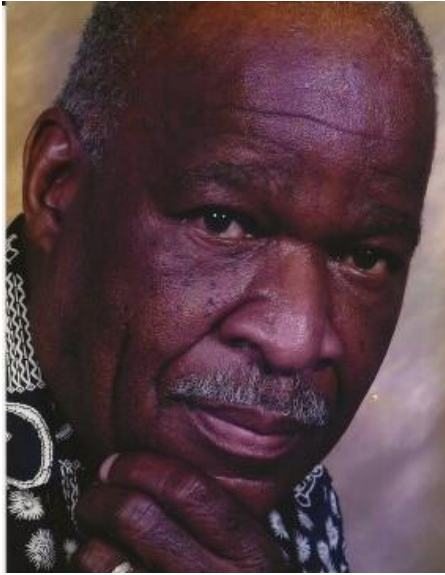


Mr. Walter Willis Wright

Obituary

Our Heavenly Father took his angel, Walter Willis Wright Sr. home on Friday, July 29, 2022, at 2:40 a.m. He succumbed at CenterPoint Medical Center in Independence, Missouri.

Walter was born September 10, 1942, in Kansas City, Missouri to the late Ned Hayes and Florence Newman. Walter had six siblings. His parents, three of his brothers Eddie Wright, Fred Wright, and Irvin Wright, sister Valencia Jeanette Hayes all preceded him in death.

On February 6, 1961, Walter and Vernestine Washington united in marriage and to this union three children were born: Conrad Wright Sr., Walter Wright Jr., and Renee Gunn. The marriage ended in 1982. Walter married Ting Roxas on July 19, 2004.

Walter professed a belief in God at an early age. He joined Sunrise Baptist Church in Kansas City, Missouri under the leadership of Reverend S.C. Clopton on January 3, 1954. He was baptized on January 10, 1954. He moved his membership to Greater Mount Zion Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend Albert Colbert. He was a current member at Macedonia Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend John Brooks. He served on the usher board until his health failed.

Walter graduated from Manual High School in 1960. He studied on the associate level Electronic Maintenance and Repair Technology at Manuel Career Technical Center. He owned W & W Maintenance Company, and he worked for Missouri Gas Energy for over fifty years. He was ambitious, even in his youth. His career began at age fourteen. He sold newspapers and cookies. Family and friends nicknamed him "Cookie" as a youngster.

Walter traveled internationally on a regular basis. He visited Israel, Egypt, Turkey, South Africa, Japan, China, the Philippines, Australia, Vietnam, Cuba and many more. He enjoyed helping others in his spare time. He volunteered at hospitals, nursing homes, and food pantries.
